As a result of the 2019–20 COVID-19 pandemic, overall demand for crude fell causing oil prices to fall sharply in March of 2020, and the Oil and Gas Industry was caught in the "Perfect Storm.". On March 6, 2020, Russia rejected the demand of additional production cuts, marking the end of the unofficial OPEC+ partnership. In response, on March 8, 2020, Saudi Arabia announced unexpected price discounts of \$6 to \$8 per barrel to customers in Europe, Asia, and the United States, starting an all-out price war. The announcement triggered a free fall in oil prices, with Brent crude falling by over 30%. Subsequently, oil prices fell to an all-time low on April 20th amid growing concerns that demand shortfalls would cause supply to exceed available storage capacity. Forced production cuts by producers around the globe have allowed the spot price of crude to rebound to 60% of January 2020 pricing, but uncertainty still exists throughout the market.

The question for oil markets is the trajectory of a demand recovery. Will oil demand return to the levels we saw at the end of 2019? If so, can additional growth be expected in excess of 2019 levels or will consumer behavior change long term with reduced travel and many companies encouraging their employees to work-from-home? What can US Exploration and Production companies do to weather this storm and what does the landscape of the Oil and Gas Industry look like for the near and long term? Do you expect to see a high number of bankruptcies or will consolidations through mergers and acquisitions be more common? Please select one, or more, of the questions herein and explain your thoughts.
